With reference to our report No 10,323 on the above vessel recently forwarded, I beg to point out the fee of £3 : 10 : 0 charged for machinery survey was based on the NHP recorded in the Register Book viz:- 95.

The Owners have since pointed out that the machinery is in all respects duplicate to that fitted in their "Manx Queen" No 372, on which they paid machinery survey fees of £2 : 10 : 0.

It appears that the NHP of the former vessel according to the Society's formula should be 67, in view of which an amended account for £2 : 10 : 0 has now been rendered to the Owners, and I would submit the record of NHP be amended in the Register Book.
