On July 15th, 1918, while the vessel was lying alongside the Quebec Harbor, outside pier the undersigned made examination and found as follows:

FOUND The jibboom broken short off about ten feet from tip.

Eye bolt in top of martingale broken.

Fore topmast stay broken.

P & S. Jibboom stay outriggers doubled up.

RECOMMENDED.

That the broken Jibboom be removed from vessel and a new jibboom

be made and fitted in place.

A new eye bolt be fitted in top of martingale.

A new fore top mast stay be fitted.

P. & S. outriggers be straightened or renewed as found necessary.

That all rigging in way of the above repairs be cleared away and again made fast when the new jibboom is fitted.
