examination of the steel screw steamer "MAROWIJNE" of New York,  
3191 tons gross register on June 22nd.1915 while the vessel  
was in dry dock at New Orleans, for the purpose of ascertaining  
the nature and extent of damage stated to have been sustained  
through the propeller having struck a submerged object in the  
Mississippi River on June 20th. 1915 while on a voyage from  
Belize to New Orleans; The shock caused the engines to vibrate.

For further particulars see Log Books and Protest.

On examination of vessel and propeller in dry dock, found,  
Three bronze blades of the built propeller bent at the tips,  
one blade bent at tip and a piece broken off about 19" x 3"  
~~REMARKS~~ The cone for the propeller nut missing.

RECOMMENDED. The bent tips of three blades to be faired in place.  
the tip of one blade to be dressed and faired as far as possible.  
It is also recommended that a new bronze blade be supplied and  
fitted at the first convenient opportunity, also a new cone.

In our opinion the vessel is in fit condition to proceed  
on her contemplated voyage.

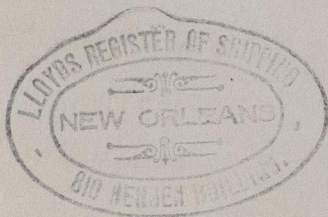
