This vessel grounded near Ramsey, Isle of Man,
on the 22nd January. She was refloated the next day,
and subsequently taken to Fleetwood, where she was placed on
a slipway. Temporary repairs were carried under the
supervision of the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool to enable
her to be towed to Hull for permanent repairs.

The vessel becoming leaky, after leaving Fleetwood,
was towed into Milford Haven, where a salvage pump was fixed
on board in accordance with the recommendation made by the
Society's Surveyor at that port. She then proceeded in
tow, but during a heavy gale she broke adrift and stranded
on Pentreath Beach, near the Lizard, on the 11th instant,
and is reported to be a total wreck.

In accordance with the usual practice a casualty
Notice was sent to the Owners on the 13th instant.

It is submitted the Vessel's class be expunged from
the Register Book, and "WRECKED" inserted.
