Nature of Survey *Com'n* *Pl. S.S. No. 3 due 12. 14 held*

The 1st S.S.No.3 which became due 12. 14 was partly held at London in May last.

Some shell plating requires to be repaired.

The London Surveyors stated in May last that the vessel was on Admiralty service.

The Sydney Surveyors now report the vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated.

The indented plates etc, have been examined and found sound.

The master stated that the necessary repairs and the Special Survey No.3 would be attended to at a home port.

The vessel now trooping.

It is submitted action be deferred.
