It is submitted this proposal might be approved and the vessel be allowed to remain as classed record of Survey, notation of

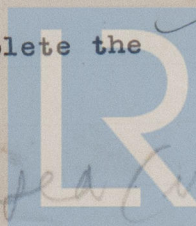
