S. With reference to Glasgow report No.42291 on turbine engines No.173/20 constructed by Messrs. John Brown & Co.Ltd., I have to acquaint you that this machinery has now been fitted on board the steamer "LONDON SHIPPER", and a first entry report having been received from the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough on the hull of the vessel, she has to-day been classed "100A1 - Shelter deck with freeboard", with notations of "LMC 8,23. F.D., C.L., Fitted for oil fuel 8,23 F.P.above 150° F. Lloyd's A & CP. Cargo Battens not fitted in shelter 'tween decks."
