The S.S. "MONITORIA" 1904 tons (No. 1382 in Register Book) was built by Messrs. Osbourne, Graham & Co. of Sunderland in July 1909 and classed 100A 1 in the Society's Register Book.

This vessel is owned by the Ericsson Shipping Co., Ltd., of Newcastle-on-Tyne, and her sides are of corrugated form in accordance with the patent under which she was constructed.

Several vessels of this type have been built but the "MONITORIA" is the only one which has this Society's classification.

When the vessel was classed by this Society, no special designation was given to her in the Register Book.

She is, however, described by her Owners as the "Monitor patent Corrugated Ship".

It is considered desirable that a vessel which in regard to form of body and mode of construction departs so much from the normal type should be indicated by some special designation in the Register Book.

It is therefore submitted that the S.S. "MONITORIA" should be described in the Register Book as "Monitor Ship; Corrugated Sides".
