S. With reference to Glasgow report No.47919 on boiler No.10782 made by Messrs. Cochran & Co., (Annam) Ltd., and to Glasgow report No.48106 on headers and mud drums, etc., for six Babcock & Wilcox water tube boilers, I have to inform you that it appears from the completed first entry reports on the new Steel T.S. "STATENDAM" which have been received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, that these boilers have now been fitted into the vessel at that port, and the survey satisfactorily completed.

The reports have received the consideration of the Committee and the vessel has been classed ~~100~~ A1 with freeboard and notations of Lloyd's A & CP, LMC 4,29, Fitted for Oil Fuel 4,29, F.P. above 150° F.
