Dear Sir,

We beg to confirm telegram sent you to-day as follows:-

"STATENDAM UPPER PROMENADE SHEERSTRAKE ONE POINT OUGHT  
FOUR INCHES WITH FIFTEEN BY POINT NINE DOUBLING AS  
APPROVED"

In explanation it may be stated that the Builders furnished a quarter scale sketch of the Midship Section showing the scantlings and arrangements of the vessel as built. On inquiry to-day it was found that the thickness of the upperstrake promenade sheerstrake was 1.04" instead of .98" as shown on the Builders' plan.

The sketch in question is enclosed herewith for reference.


