The above vessel which was built at Rangoon has been totally a fact of which you are probably aware.

According to a letter from your Surveyor, Mr. R.P. Taylor, addressed to Messrs. J. & F. Graham & Co., Rangoon dated the 17th June, Messrs. Graham & Co. were informed that the amended plans of theentine "Armenia" have been approved by the Committee of Lloyd's Register, London, and the Secretary of that Society informed the Surveyor should the vessel be built in accordance with the plans, and the ship and the material be found to their satisfaction, she would completion eligible to be classed A.1 for a period of sixteen years.

The insurance on the Ship was effected by us with a Warranty the vessel should be so classed, but up to the present time no notification or information is to be discovered in the Register.
