Sir,

With reference to Greenock Report No.11169 and Glasgow Report No.30995 of survey held on the new steamer "HURUNUI", I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today the reports from the Society's Surveyors here on the completion of the First Entry survey, and the fitting of new hawse pipes, and that the vessel has been classed 100A1, "Shelter Deck, with Freeboard", and with notations of SLMC 12,11 and Lloyd's A&CP.

The last date of survey in the case was the 25th January 1912 and this will accordingly be taken as the date of build of the vessel. The classification certificates are enclosed herewith.

With regard to the fact that it has been found necessary to fit new hawse pipes in the steamer, I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which has been addressed to the Greenock Surveyors on the subject today.
