With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "KIRKLAND", I beg to remind you that the screw shaft of this vessel has not been drawn in for examination by the Society's Surveyors since she was built in November, 1908, and as the Society's Rules require this to be done at intervals of not more than two years I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know for the information of the Committee when and at what port you propose complying with this requirement.

At the same time I beg to acquaint you that the Special Survey No.1 prescribed by the Society's Rules became due on this vessel at the end of last month and I shall also be glad if you will kindly let me know what arrangements you propose making to have this inspection carried out.

I enclose for your information an abstract from the Rules describing the requirements of this Survey.
