I have to acquaint you that the General Committee of this Society have had before them to-day the first entry report on the new steamer "MUNISLA", The Great Lakes Engineering Works' No.159.

It is noted that this vessel is similar to the steamers "INTERNATIONAL" and "CLINCHFIELD", and intended for the same trade as the latter vessel; and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the General Committee have decided to assign the class "100A1 For River St.Lawrence and coasting service to West Indies"; but this case is not to be taken as a precedent.

Certificates for the hull and machinery will follow by next mail.
