Dear Sirs,

E. I am returning to you, under separate cover, two sets of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 4th instant in connexion with Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson's Yard Nos. 1580 & 1582, and have to acquaint you that the plans (Drg.No.13315, Sheets 2,3 & 4) of pipe arrangement in machinery space and the plan (Drg.No.13316) of arrangement of boiler mountings will be approved for a boiler working pressure of 210 lb. per sq.inch, provided the mixing steam valves, marked B.M.1 and B.M.2, be of non-return type; all steam pipes, valves and fittings, subjected to a temperature above 425<sup>o</sup>F, be of steel; the drainage arrangements be to your satisfaction and the whole of the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

It is concluded that the boiler safety valves are of the Improved High Lift Type, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.
