I beg to inform you that in accordance with instructions contained in your wire of the 2nd instant I visited the Newcastle district on Saturday and Monday the 3rd and 5th instant respectively, and joined with Mr. Harrison, the Society's Principal Surveyor, and the Owners' and Underwriters Surveyors on a survey of the damage alleged to have been recently sustained by the vessel.

There is ample evidence of the vessel having been on the ground, and I was in a position to inform them that when she went out of dock in April last the bottom was then fair and in a good condition, and that her present damage has been sustained since she left this port.


I am informed that the repairs to the bottom have been agreed to and are now put in hand.
