E. I have to send herewith a copy of a letter of yesterday's date received from the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool respecting the air receivers for the oil engines of the "KINGSHOLME", Messrs. I. J. Abdela & Mitchell's No. 355 vessel, and with regard thereto I have to request that you will state whether these air receivers were constructed under your survey and tested by you.

If not, I have to request that you will endeavour to obtain a plan of the receivers, and particulars as to their process of manufacture, and ascertain what tests of material are available and by whom those tests were made, and whether there is any guarantee that each receiver has been annealed after the last process of manufacture, and for what working pressure they are intended.
