The Owners ask that the Marseilles Surveyor may be advised accordingly and asked to pass as much of the survey as can possibly be done without causing any delay to the steamer.

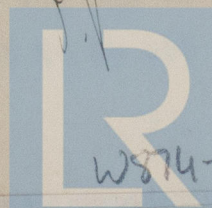
