

Repairs, if any, and, in detail, the nature of the damage (the cause of which must be stated) should be separated from Repairs and being detailed in the body of the report, should be briefly summarised at the end of the report. State also the initials of any letters respecting this case.

In cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he is required to state whether he offered his services for the purpose or not.
