Gentlemen,

I have to acquaint you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull that the S.S. "HELGIAN" built by Messrs. Cochrane & Sons, Ltd. (Yard No. 589) has proceeded to your port where her machinery is to be fitted.

To complete the survey of the hull the following remains to be done :- the engine and boiler casings and the deck in way of same riveted, etc., the masts, spars, rigging, sails and steamwinch to be fitted; the first bower anchor and the hawsers and warps to be supplied.


