First Entry

The Grimsby Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has proceeded to their port to have her Machinery fitted, and that to complete the survey on the hull the following remains to be done:— the engine and boiler casings and the deck in way of same riveted, etc; the masts, spars, rigging, sails and steam winch to be fitted; the first bower anchor and the hawsers and warps to be supplied.

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work should forward a report on Form 8 in the usual manner with a view to the classification of the vessel.
