Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 1st instant having reference to the Trawlers "ORIZABA", "CARIEDA", "HELICIA" and "JAMES RECKITT", I beg to say that with regard to the "ORIZABA", the Owners state that the windlass, 2nd anchor's ropes have been renewed. The vessel will return here in three weeks when this will be verified.

The Trawlers "CARIEDA" and "JAMES RECKITT" are here and will be surveyed before going to sea.

With regard to the "HELICIA" this vessel is at sea and it is stated that the repairs to the Boiler Stools were completed here but we were not advised. On her return here in three weeks a survey will be made and the case reported.
