Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the steamer "HELICIA", and in reply I think it well to explain that in accordance with the Society's Special Surveys Nos. 1, 2 and 3 of vessels classed as A, B and C become due at the expiration of four, eight and twelve years respectively from the date of build, and subsequently at the expiration of like periods from the date recorded in the Register Book of the previous Special Survey No. 3.

In the case of the above vessel, therefore, the Special Survey No. 2 became due eight years from the date of build, viz:- at the end of May last, and is required by the Rules to be completed within the year of grace, viz:- by the end of May, 1915.
