I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of the new steamer "HELVETIA", and in reply to point out that in view of the fact that this vessel is not fitted with cargo battens, the class assigned by the Committee is in accordance with paragraph six Section 42 of the Rules, and you will therefore see that in order to entitle the steamer to have this condition removed from her classification it will be necessary for cargo battens to be fitted as required by paragraph 5, Section 42 of the Rules.
