M. I have to acquaint you that it appears from the First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Leith on the new Steamer "HENRI LE COUR" that the vessel has proceeded to the Tyne to receive her engines and boilers.

To complete the Survey of the Hull, the decks require to be flooded, the after peak tank to be tested, the tunnel closing plating and casings to be riveted up, Downton pumps to be tested, Watertight doors to be examined and worked, the bulkheads to be tested by hose, if necessary, and the freeboard to be verified.

I shall be glad if you will be so good as to give these matters the necessary attention and to forward your report in due course with a view to the classification of the vessel.
