Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 7th instant relative to the First Entry Report on the Steamer "JACATRA" and note that the report on the hull of this vessel was received from the Greenock Surveyors on Monday, 27th May. In view of the last date of survey of the hull having been 14th May, I am communicating with the Greenock Surveyors drawing their attention to the period which was allowed to elapse before the case was reported, and I enclose herewith a copy of the letter for your information.

With regard to the unnecessary delay which has taken place in handing in the reports in the present instance I shall be glad if Mr. Dodd will be so good as to arrange that in future cases the Surveyors will complete and hand in their First Entry Reports within a day or two of the completion of the vessel, and I have to add that it is specially important that the greatest promptitude should be exercised in cases of new vessels built for Owners abroad.
