I have to confirm the following telegrams which have passed between us to-day, viz:-

Sent:- "JACATRA wire at once when you handed machinery
"certificate to Engineers and when they posted it to
"Owners or to whom they handed it and when very urgent"

Received:- "JACATRA machinery certificate handed Engineers
"Wednesday morning and posted by them to Owners
"Rotterdam same day"

With regard to the delay which has taken place in this case, I have to acquaint you that the Owners state in a letter received to-day on the subject of the certificates "We would point out to you that the late delivery of these documents is rather annoying as we cannot get our Dutch certificates ere we produce the classification certificates from your Society, and it may be that the Steamer, which is timed to sail Saturday morning tide will now be delayed".
