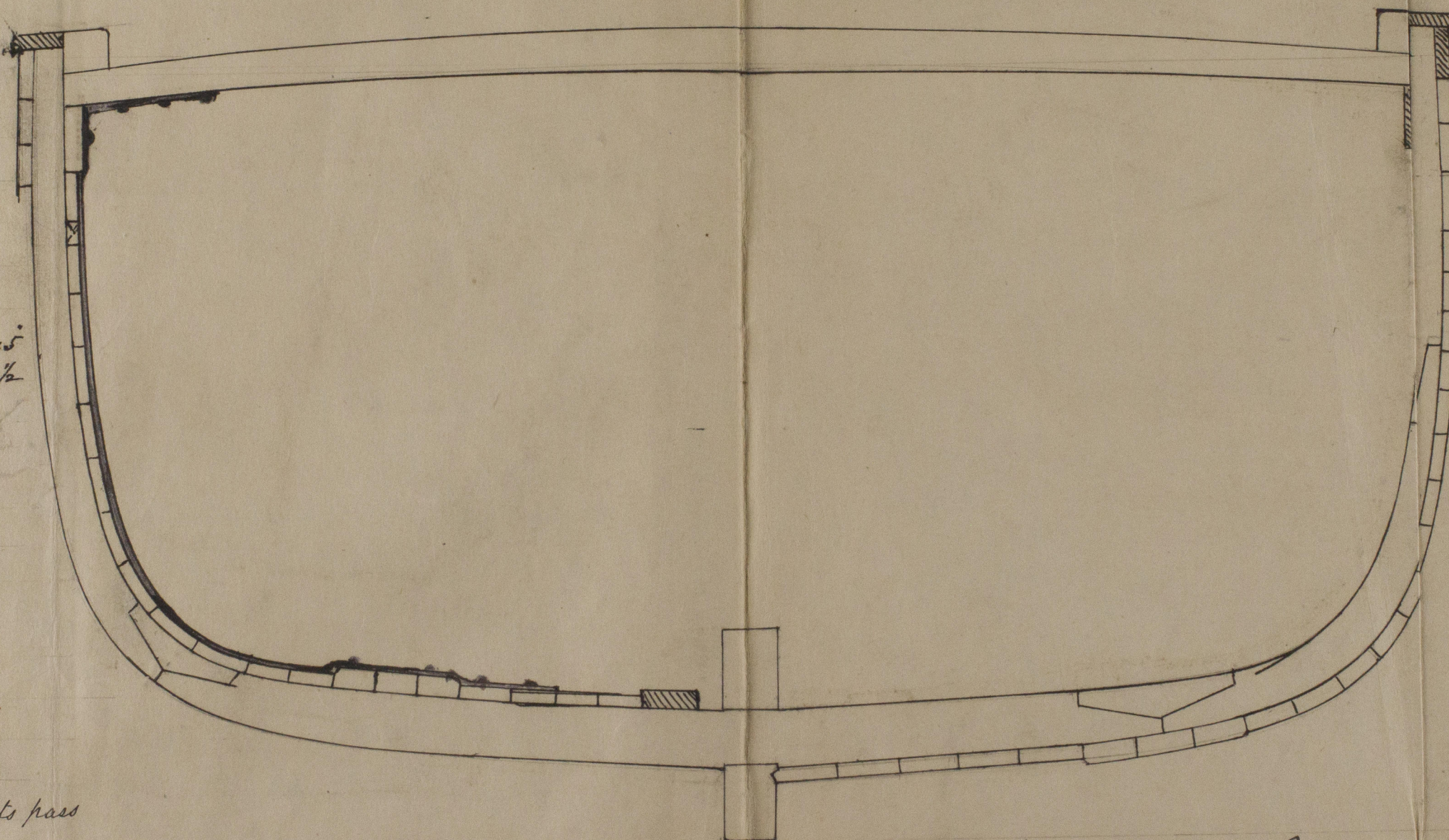

C<sup>d</sup> Salted, Yellow metal fastenings exclusive of Iron for four fifths the depth of the hold, the remaining one fifth to be Galv<sup>d</sup> Iron bolts  
Approximate Gross tonnage, 133 tons.

Double lodging knees fitted in each space between D<sup>th</sup> Beams to be of Eng Oak securely bolted through Outside planking Six pairs of Iron Rider Knees to be fitted to deck beams extending down to receive two bolts in the floor arms.  
Bolts to the required height to be Y. Metal the remainder Gal<sup>v</sup> Iron Bolts

The vessel to be salted as per Rule Section 37 and the rules in all other respects to be complied with.
