H. Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the Half Time Survey of the Schooner "ELIZABETH PRITCHARD" was partly held at Portmadoc in August 1916 and that to complete this inspection the metal sheathing requires to be stripped and the Vessel caulked down to the keel, the metal bolts tested, and the standing rigging lifted and overhauled. The Committee agreed to continue the Vessel's class, subject to these requirements being complied with by the end of the present month, and as it appears that the Vessel is now the Property of Mr. James Ryan of your Port, I shall be glad to learn as soon as possible what definite arrangements have been made, with a view to the Half Time Survey being completed.
