Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 7th instant, respecting the survey recently held by the Society's Surveyor at Portmadoc on the Wood Schooner "ELIZABETH PRICHARD", lately purchased by Mr. James Ryan of St. John's N.F.L., I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had this case under consideration.

The Surveyor reports that the Half Time Survey - which would become due under the Society's Rules in December next - has now been completed, excepting that the metal sheathing requires to be stripped and the vessel caulked down to the keel, the metal bolts tested and the standing rigging lifted and overhauled; and I have the pleasure to say that the vessel's class - viz. 13 A 1 - has been continued subject to the above requirements being completed by the end of August 1917.
