I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant respecting the Wood Schooner "ELIZABETH PRITCHARD", and in reply I have the pleasure to say that, provided sufficient metal is stripped to enable the Surveyor to satisfy himself as to the condition of the planking and caulking, the stripping of the remainder may be postponed until March, 1917, if, in the opinion of the Surveyor, it is unnecessary to strip it now.
