In reply to your letter of the 23rd inst duly received, respecting Dublin Report on Electric Lighting Installation on the new Steel Steamer "Ferga" I beg respectfully to state that the Amperage was entered in error & same is now corrected & corresponds with that of the Dynamo - viz 40 Amperes. In a letter enclosed, from the Electrical Engineer - he gives his reasons for this overstatement of the Cable Amperage. Inasmuch as this letter admits & gives the Section of these twin Cables as .014, whereas it should be .017-; I would be obliged if you would be good enough to let me know if this can be accepted before making any recommendation on my report which is enclosed.
