M With reference to my letter of the 22nd instant respecting the steel screw steamer No. 453 to be built by Messrs. Cochrane & Sons, I am directed to acquaint you that the question of the equipment for this vessel received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting today, when it was decided that to entitle the vessel to the figure 1 the equipment should be supplied in accordance with that required by an extension of Table 22 for Steam Trawlers, as in previous similar cases, viz:-
