Sir,

I beg to forward herewith a letter received to-day from the Ministry of Shipping, Transport Department, relative to the damage sustained to the tank top plating in Nos. 2 and 3 Holds s/s "HARMATTAN" Cardiff report No. 39590; and presume that the same will be replied to from the Society's Head Office.

From the nature of the damage, and the relatively short time the vessel had been engaged in carrying horses, it would appear that some highly corrosive action- probably by the urine combining with the sulphur or other agent in the coal- caused the damage referred to.
