Sir,

In sending in my report on the machinery of the Steamer "HARPAGUS", Gray's S.S. No. 771, I respectfully beg to state that both the Owners and the Central Marine Engine Works request that the Horse Power be marked as high as possible in the Register Book by counting in the No. 4 boiler. This gives a horse power of 574. The fees, however, are charged on the machinery and the three forced draught boilers, in which case the horse power is 537, the fee being £46. 17. 0. while the fee for the Auxiliary boiler on 1074 square feet of heating surface is £3. 11. 6., making a total of £50. 8. 6. This meets with the approval of the Central Marine Engine Works.
