The Board of Trade Survey is required for tonnage of the vessel which appears in Lloyds Book. Of course the p not being quite completed Lloyds Surveyors at West Hartlepool e to report this to London Office, but I have got them to suggest head quarters that as without a doubt the survey will be completed would very much oblige the Owners if the full entry were made.

I would advise you seeing Lloyd's in London and asking them to in the full entry.

I have requested them to put in 4 Main Boilers with total Heating Grate Surface.

Lloyds fear it will be Saturday at the soonest before their report ll go in. Board of Trade send theirs in to Whitehall tonight, it then to come back to them. "
