I duly received your letter of the 2nd instant forwarding a letter from Messrs. Osbourne, Graham & Co., relative to the date of build of the new steamer "FIGULINA".

Upon enquiry of the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle, it appears that the vessel was not seen while on the slipway there, but that she is still in the Tyne, and they are being requested to make a general examination of her afloat with a view to the circumstances being submitted to the Committee for their decision.

At the same time, I have to request you will state whether it is to be understood that this vessel has been laid up in the Builders hands since the date of the last visit paid by you, namely, 1st November.
