First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Newcastle Surveyors should be written to with reference to the omission of ceiling from the tank top of this vessel. Their attention should be directed to Circular No.1089 where it is stated that the alteration in the Rules respecting the fitting of ceiling will not come into force until the expiration of six months, say until the 14th June 1906, but it may be taken advantage of in the case of the vessels already built, and of those which may be built or contracted for before that date, on the request of the Owners. The Surveyors will thus see that it is necessary for the consent of the Owners to be obtained in the present instance, and they should make this clear to the Builders with a view to the written consent of the Owners ^{being} obtained.
