Nature of Survey First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Newcastle Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is reported by the Hartlepool Surveyors to have sustained damage to the stern through collision, and that she has proceeded to the Tyne for loading and the repairs are to be carried out at that port. The Newcastle Surveyors should be requested to state by return post whether the repairs are being carried out to their satisfaction in order that the first entry report may be laid before the Committee on Tuesday morning next with a view to the vessel's classification.
