Sir,

In reply to your letter of yesterday's date respecting the First Entry Report 6998 on the T.S. "Galway Castle" I beg to state that the Middle Line Strake of Double bottom was 54" in thickness amidships and the rivets attaching the frames and plating were six dia. apart. I regret that these items were incorrectly reported.

The riveting of middle line strake is in accordance with the Rules, edges double butts treble, and these items have been added to the Report, which is returned herewith.

With reference to the Report Forms, I beg to state that the supply sent down in February last not having been opened, we were unaware of any alteration; the new forms will be used in all future cases as requested.
