It is submitted that, before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, this report should be returned to the Belfast Surveyors & they should be requested to state if they are correct in stating the centre strake is 54" x 144 & the spacing of the rivets through the frames & the outside plating 7 diameters apart; they should be requested to state if the edges of the middle line strake are double riveted & the butts treble riveted for $\frac{1}{2}$ length as required by the Rules.

The Surveyors should also be requested in future cases to use the Report forms of the most recent date.
