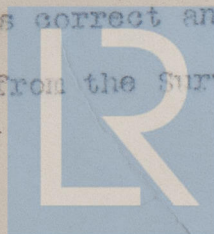
Sir,

S. With reference to Glasgow First Entry report No. 24018 on the hull of the Steamer "GLENRAVEL" I have to acquaint you that the Classing Committee had the case of this vessel before them today with the first entry report on the machinery which has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Belfast and that they have assigned to her the class of 100 A1 & LMC 5,06 accordingly.

As the certificate for the survey of the machinery is specially asked for I have forwarded it to the Belfast Surveyors with an instruction that it should not be handed over until receipt of an advice from you to the effect that the fees for the Special Survey of the hull have all been paid.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly advise the Belfast Surveyors accordingly.

In view of the Rule depth in this case being 17.2ft. it is not quite clear whether the record of decks as stated on the third page of the report is correct and I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors and let me
