

Steel Screw Steamer "TIMAVO". Built at Trieste by the  
Cantiere San Rocco.

The Classing Committee had before them on  
Tuesday, 11th instant, the First Entry reports on this  
vessel, with a special submission as regards the date of  
build to be recorded in the Register Book.

The steamer was commenced in July, 1914 and  
launched in December, 1917 and completed on the 11th  
November, 1920.


The Surveyor states that the vessel has been  
moored at the Builders' yard from the date she was launched  
and has been well looked after. In February, 1918 she broke  
adrift during a gale of wind and stranded on a breakwater.

She was placed in dry dock in August, 1920,  
when the bottom and rudder were examined and repairs to the  
shell and framing carried out. The repairs consisted of  
dealing with ten shell plates, eight wing brackets and the  
starboard bilge keel at that time and the general condition  
of the bottom is stated to have been quite satisfactory.

As the vessel appears to have been carefully  
attended to during the war and has been under the supervision  
of the Society's Surveyors throughout, and was in dry dock so  
recently as August last, the Chief Ship Surveyors submit that  
the date of build might be recorded as August, 1920.

Somewhat similar cases of vessels built during  
the war in the Trieste district are as follow:-

s.s. "CLARA CAMUS". Commenced in September, 1913  
and launched in November,  
1914. The General Committee agreed to the date of the last  
examination in drydock, namely April, 1920, being recorded as  
the date of build.

s.s. "CHERCA". Commenced May, 1914.  
Launched July, 1916.

Seen in drydock June, 1920. Date of Build June, 1920.

s.s. "GENERALE PETTITI". Commenced September, 1913.  
Launched December, 1914.

Docked May, 1920. Date of Build recorded May, 1920.

It should be observed that in none of these cases, however, has there been any question of damage sustained by the steamer while lying under construction.
