It is submitted the Sunderland Surveyors be informed that this vessel has proceeded to the North Eastern Marine Engineering Co's works at their port to receive her machinery, and that to complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done:— the chain locker to be flooded, the winch deck tanks and the fresh water tanks at the break of the quarter deck to be tested; the decks to be flooded, the tunnel to be tested and the W.T. doors, Downton pump and hand pumps to be examined and tested.

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on the completion of the work to forward a report on Form 8 in the usual manner with a view to the classification of the vessel.
