The Algiers Surveyor now reports that the vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom recoated and the shell riveting overhauled.

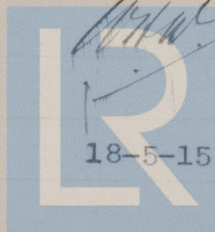
It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey subject as above.
