The vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom & rudder examined & the following repairs now effected:—
One length of Bilge Keel on Port side cut off, faired & refitted and general shell rivets renewed & landing edges recaulked.
The bow plates (P & S) on C.D. & strakes & the stem plate on B strake were found to be indented; these indentations do not affect the vessel's efficiency & may be dealt with at the next special survey.
