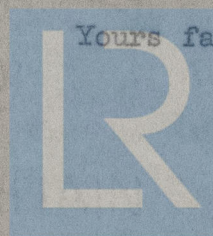

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant advising plan, in duplicate, of orlop deck beams to be fitted in No. 1 hold of the "TERJE VIKEN", and with regard thereto I shall be glad if you will discuss the plan with the Builders, and point out that the scantlings and arrangements of the beams etc. as shewn and amended in red could be approved, on the understanding that the density of the cargo to be carried on the orlop deck does not exceed that represented by 70 cu. ft. per ton. If, however, the cargo to be carried is of normal density, namely, 50 cu. ft. per ton. the, the scantlings of the beams etc. should be as further amended in green. The result of your discussion with the Builders should be reported to this Office for record purposes.

One copy of the plan in question is being returned under separate cover, the duplicate being retained for reference.
