Cond'n Reported Leakages

The Barry Surveyors reported in January last that this vessel had been examined afloat and by a diver owing to leakage in way of cross bunker.

Temporary repairs were effected, and it was recommended that same be again dealt with after the cargo had been discharged at Marseilles.

On the 26th January the Marseilles' Surveyor reported that he had examined the temporary repairs, and further temporary repairs had been effected.

He recommended that the vessel be examined and permanent repairs be carried out on arrival at a home port.

The Bristol Surveyor now reports, the cross bunker has been cleared, limbers lifted, bilges cleaned and examined.

The cement in pocket over bolt, fitted at Barry, found sound and no leakage in bilge.

Owing to the difficulty in obtaining a dry dock the Owners wished to postpone permanent repairs to a more favourable time, which proposal, in the Surveyor's opinion, is satisfactory.

The Surveyor recommends that permanent repairs be effected at the first convenient opportunity.
