It is submitted the Sunderland Surveyors be informed that this vessel has proceeded to Sunderland where her machinery is to be placed on board at the works of the North Eastern Marine Engineering Company, and that to complete the Hull the following requires to be done:— the tunnel in the after hold clear of the after recess to test, the downton pump to test, the steam steering gear and windlass test under steam and the beams and casing removed for shipping the machinery to be replaced and riveted up. They should be requested to give these matters the necessary attention and forward a report on form No.8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
