Messrs. R. Craggs & Sons' No. 222 vessel (S.S. "BRIKA") has left here for your port, where her machinery will be placed on board at the works of Messrs. The North Eastern Marine Engineering Co. Ltd.,

The approved Pumping Plan is enclosed for your reference.

To complete the First Entry Survey on the vessel, the following remains to be done, viz:-

- (1) Tunnel in After hold clear of after recess to test.
- (2) Downton Pump to test.
- (3) Steam Steering Gear to test under steam.
- (4) Windlass to test under steam.
- (5) Beams and casing removed for shipping machinery to be replaced and riveted up.

I shall be glad if you will kindly attend to the foregoing and report to the Committee in the usual course.
